Guidance for letters of recommendation

- 1. How well do you know the applicant, and under what circumstances did you have contact with them?
- 2. What strengths and unique contributions does the applicant offer to the research fellowship?
- 3. How do you assess the applicant's motivation for medical physics? As much as possible, include examples of various qualities or characteristics of the above.
- 4. Describe how the applicant has demonstrated or developed *any* of the following (provide specific examples if appropriate):

Intellectual & Problem-Solving Capabilities

- Critical Thinking & Quantitative Reasoning
- Intellectual Curiosity
- Scientific Inquiry: applies the scientific process to problems, research questions, hypotheses
- Knowledge of Natural Sciences and Computation
